

MISSISSIPPI STATE BOARD OF COSMETOLOGY AND BARBERING
Board Meeting Minutes
October 28, 2024

1. WELCOME AND CALL TO ORDER

Warren Rossi called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Ruby Lowery provided a roll call with the following present:

2. INVOCATION

Mike McBunch provided the invocation.

3. AGENDA APPROVAL

The agenda was amended to include the following:

Item 4(a) was removed from the agenda.

Linell Palmer, Jr. moved to accept the agenda as amended. Mike McBunch provided a second. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

4. BOARD MINUTE APPROVAL

Linell Palmer, Jr. moved to approve the Board minutes from the September 28, 2024, meeting. Clelly Farmer provided the second. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

Clelly Famer moved to approve the Board minutes from the September 29, 2024, meeting. Bennie Lee Adkins provided the second. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

Bennie Lee Adkins moved to approve the Board minutes from the September 30, 2024, meeting. Clelly Farmer provided the second. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

5. AGENDA REQUEST

Melvin Calton addressed the Board and discussed the Board's proposed rule for school square footage as well as the proposed student to instructor ratio for schools. The Board took no action.

Debbie Coker addressed the Board and requested the creation of an ad hoc rules committee comprised of practitioners, instructors, school owners, salon/shop

owners, Board members, and Board office staff. Ms. Coker also discussed the curriculum resources of MS Research Curriculum Unit for Community college cosmetology and barber instruction as well as NACCAS curriculum. The Board took no action.

6. OFFICER AND COMMITTEE REPORTS

Warren Rossi had no Board Chairman report.

Bennie Lee Adkins had no Board Vice Chairman report.

Catherine Bell reported on the ad hoc committee on rules and regulations. The Board reviewed proposed rules and regulations discussing chapters seven (7) and eight (8). Ms. Bell will revise the proposed rules and regulations to reflect the Board discussion. No action was taken.

Ruby Lowery reported on the ad hoc committee on inspector requirements/job description. No action was taken.

7. UPDATE FROM NIC CONFERENCE

Ruby Lowery and Porcia Welch provided an update to the Board from the NIC Conference. No action was taken.

8. LICENSE/WORK PERMITS/APPROVAL LETTER REPORT

Ruby Lowery provided an update of all applications made and licenses issued for September for the professions of cosmetology, nail technology, and esthetics. Linell Palmer, Jr. moved, seconded by Mike McBunch, to approve all licenses/work permits as stated. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried. A copy of the accepted licenses is attached hereto as "Exhibit A".

Ann Welch provided an update on all applications made and licenses issued for both August and September for the barbering profession. Mike McBunch moved, seconded by Clelly Farmer, to approve all licenses/work permits as stated. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried. A copy of the accepted licenses is attached hereto as "Exhibit B".

Ruby Lowery discussed the testing grievance filed by a cosmetology applicant and reported that after allowing the applicant to review photographs of the contested skill, the applicant withdrew the grievance. The Board took no action.

9. CONTINUING EDUCATION

The Board reviewed the application from RocketCert, LLC for eight (8) hours of online CE instruction for cosmetology licensees. Linell Palmer, Jr. moved, seconded by Bennie Lee Adkins, to deny Rocket Cert, LLC as a CE provider. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

10. COMPLIANCE

Ruby Lowery provided an update of all establishments inspected and violations issued for the previous month for the professions of cosmetology, nail technology, and esthetics. No action was taken.

Ann Welch provided an update on all establishments inspected and violations issued for the previous month for the barbering profession. No action was taken.

TESTING EVALUATORS

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Dr. Mary Gayle Armstrong moved to go into closed session to determine whether an Executive Session was needed. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

Bennie Lee Adkins moved, seconded by Clelly Farmer, that the Board had reason to go into Executive Session pursuant to MISS. CODE ANN. § 25-41-7, discussion of the practical examination. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

Within Executive Session the following action was taken:

Linell Palmer, Jr. moved, seconded by Mike McBunch, to cancel Oliver Sampson's contract with the Board and not permit Ms. Sampson to be a practical examination evaluator. The voice vote was as follows:

Warren Rossi - aye

Clelly Farmer - no

Bennie Lee Adkins - abstained

Dr. Mary Gayle Armstrong - aye

Michael McBunch - aye

Linell Palmer, Jr. - aye

With the majority in favor, the motion passed.

Linell Palmer, Jr. moved, seconded by Dr. Mary Gayle Armstrong, to permit the three (3) cosmetology practical exam applicants (K. Barnes, E. Hart, and T. Simmons) who were erroneously disqualified from the hair cut portion of the practical exam due to the mannequin type the student brought to the exam to be permitted to retest the hair cut portion of the practical examination at no cost to the student. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

Mike McBunch, seconded by Dr. Mary Gayle Armstrong, moved to exit Executive Session and return to Open Session. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

11. OLD BUSINESS

The scheduling of case number(s) 2024-08-18995-01; 2024-02-66427-1; 2024-01-65462-1; and 2024-07-42015-1 remained on the table. No action was taken.

12. NEW BUSINESS

Linell Palmer, Jr. moved, seconded by Mike McBunch, that a "brush up" student enrollment was considered by the Board to be a new student enrollment. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

Clelly Farmer, seconded by Bennie Lee Adkins, moved to permit the following esthetics brush up students from Blue Cliff College to sit for the licensure examination once all required applications and fees have been properly submitted: D. Jones, S. Joseph, C. Sanson, J. Moyers, and D. Robins. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

On 1/28/2024, the former Mississippi State Board of Cosmetology adopted a policy that all senior licenses were not required to provide an updated picture or continuing education hours when renewing the license. Additionally, senior licensees would not be required to apply for the written and practical

examination when reviewing a license that has been lapsed for three (3) years or more. However, MISS. CODE ANN. § 73-7-19 requires that all licensees whose license has lapsed for three (3) or more years must reapply and retest both sections. Additionally, continuing education submission for instructor licensee is twenty-four (24) hours per MISS. CODE ANN. § 73-7-15 and eight (8) for a master licensee as per MISS. CODE ANN. § 73-7-14.

Linell Palmer, Jr., seconded by Mike McBunch, moved to withdraw the policy adopted by the former Mississippi State Board of Cosmetology on January 28, 2024, concerning senior licensees (aged 70 and over) to comply with statutory requirements and for a senior licensee to also be required to submit a photograph as per Board rules with a license renewal. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

Dr. Mary Gayle Armstrong, seconded by Clelly Farmer, moved to permit all senior licensees, effected by the former Mississippi State Board of Cosmetology's January 28, 2024, policy on continuing education submission, to have an additional one (1) year or until December 31, 2025, to submit all required continuing education hours for licensure renewal. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

The Board reviewed the request from Courtney A. Duduley (Kourtknie AmilliDreem) for undocumented recognition of cosmetology educational hours. Linell Palmer, Jr. moved, seconded by Bennie Lee Adkins, to deny Ms. Duduley's (Ms. AmilliDreem) request as there is no documentation supporting that Ms. Dudley/AmilliDreem completed the alleged education. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

The Board noted that Pearl River Community College submitted an application for the cosmetology program and that the school was in the geographical territory of Clelly Farmer who was also an instructor at the school over twenty (20) years prior). Bennie Lee Adkins moved, seconded by Mike McBunch, that Clelly Farmer's previous employment at the school would not prohibit him from serving as the Board member to perform the school inspection required when opening a new school or program and for Clelly Farmer to serve as the Board member for the school inspection. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

The Board reviewed the photograph from Phuong-Anh T. Tran's previous license as well as the photographs submitted by Mr. Tran with the licensure renewal request. Dr. Mary Gayle Armstrong moved, seconded by Linell Palmer, Jr., for Ms. Tran to appear in person at the Board office and for a member of the Board office to photograph Ms. Tran at the office then use that photograph for Ms. Tran's licensure renewal. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

13. APPROVAL OF EXPENSES

There were no expenses that required approval.

14. FINANCIAL REPORT

Denise DeRossette with Cornerstone provided the human resources and financial report. Ms. DeRossette reported that open enrollment was taking place during October and there was a possibility, if the Board office was interested, in the

addition of a cafeteria plan. Ms. DeRossette discussed the need to recruit for investigator positions.

Dr. Mary Gayle Armstrong moved, seconded by Linell Palmer, Jr., to approve the recruitment for investigator positions. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

Mike McBunch moved, seconded by Dr. Mary Gayle Armstrong, to accept the financial report pending audit. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

15. FORMAL COMPLAINTS

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Dr. Mary Gayle Armstrong moved to go into closed session to determine whether an Executive Session was needed. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

Mike McBunch moved, seconded by Dr. Mary Gayle Armstrong, that the Board had reason to go into Executive Session pursuant to MISS. CODE ANN. § 25-41-7, investigative proceedings regarding allegations of misconduct or violations of law. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

Within Executive Session the following action was taken:


The Board took no action on the following complaints: FC20240624-001; FC20240716-001; and G2024-85H/3.

Bennie Lee Adkins, seconded by Clelly Farmer, moved to exit Executive Session and return to Open Session. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

16. ADJOURNMENT

Mike McBunch, seconded by Linell Palmer, Jr., moved to adjourn at 2:26 pm. The voice vote was unanimous. Motion carried.
