Chapter 13 Establishments: Mobile Salon / Barber Shop

Rule 13.1 Mobile Salon / Barber Shop A mobile salon / barber shop is a self-contained, licensed vehicle, trailer or other transportable unit that is designed, equipped and operated to provide barbering, cosmetology, esthetics and/or nail technology services that is affiliated with a permanently located salon/barber shop.

A mobile salon / barber shop is affiliated with a permanently located salon/barber shop if it is connected through ownership or written contractual relationship.

Rule 13.2 Unlicensed Practice Prohibited A mobile salon / barber shop license holder must ensure that all persons performing or offering to perform any service within the scope of practice of any profession licensed by this Board are properly licensed at all times. No one shall work within the scope of practice of any profession licensed by the Board within a mobile salon / barber shop without a valid license or permit.

A mobile salon / barber shop may not perform or offer to perform any service within the scope of any profession licensed by this Board that is outside of the scope of the establishment's license.

Rule 13.3 Enforcement The holder of a mobile salon / barber shop license is the owner of the establishment with which the mobile salon / barber shop is affiliated. The holder of the mobile salon / barber shop license shall be responsible for the implementation and maintenance of the sanitary conditions of the establishment as well as compliance with all Board rules and regulations. Any licensee shall be held individually responsible for the implementation and maintenance of the sanitary conditions of his station and/or equipment as well as compliance with all Board rules and regulations

Rule 13.4 Posting Board Required Information A licensed mobile salon / barber shop must post in a conspicuous place any information or announcement so required by the Board.

Rule 13.5 Mobile Salon / Barber Shop License Application All mobile salon / barber shops where any profession licensed by the Board is practiced must also hold an establishment license. An application entitled “mobile salon / barber shop establishment application” available on the Board’s website or otherwise may be made available by the Board. The application must be accompanied by the non-refundable application fee and all documents required by the Board.

A mobile salon / barber shop license is non-transferable. Any change to the ownership and/or name requires the submission of a new mobile salon / barber shop license application. No license shall be issued until all fines previously assessed to the establishment have been paid in full.

Rule 13.6 Required Equipment A mobile salon / barber shop shall contain sufficient equipment in working order to enable it to perform all services offered competently and efficiently. A complete list of Board required equipment is available on the Board’s website or otherwise may be made available by the Board.

Rule 13.7 Minimum Requirements for Mobile Salon / Barber Shop A mobile salon / barber shop must comply with the following standards:

- A. The mobile salon / barber shop shall be legally parked in a fixed position and fully stationary (not in motion) when rendering any service;
- B. When in motion, all furniture and equipment must be securely anchored to the unit;
- C. All storage units must be secured by the use of spring struts or friction catches;
- D. Carpeting is permitted only within the driving or cab area (if applicable);
- E. The mobile salon / barber shop shall have and use stabilizing jacks;
- F. Containers in the mobile salon / barber shop must consist of galvanized stainless steel or other noncorrosive material, not including glass;
- G. All chemicals must be stored in secured cabinets, separate from other articles or equipment in the mobile salon / barber shop;
- H. The mobile salon / barber shop shall not be used as a residence or for any other purpose besides providing approved services;
- I. The mobile salon / barber shop shall comply with all requirements set forth in Chapter 11 of these Rules and Regulations.

- J. All services must be performed within the licensee's mobile salon/barber shop.
- K. The mobile salon/barber shop must be well ventilated.
- L. The mobile salon/barber shop must contain a fire extinguisher.

Rule 13.8 Water / Restroom Access

- A. A mobile salon / barber shop must have:
 - a. a water heater that provides fresh, hot water continuously and on demand; and
 - b. a fresh water tank holding a sufficient amount of fresh water to perform the day's business. If a mobile establishment unit's fresh water supply is depleted, operation must cease until the supply is replenished; and
 - c. a gray water tank which is permanently and distinctly labeled for such use; and
 - d. a functioning restroom within its perimeter including a self-contained, recirculating, flush chemical toilet with holding tank.

Rule 13.9 Mobile Salon / Barber Shop License Inspection A mobile salon / barber shop license cannot be issued until after an inspection by the Board or a Board agent is successfully passed. The establishment inspection may be scheduled only after the submission of a complete application as per Rule 13.5. If an applicant fails to appear at the scheduled inspection date and time, the applicant must pay a re-inspection fee, unless good cause is shown in writing, before another inspection may be scheduled.

The license number of the mobile salon/barber shop shall be posted on the mobile salon/barber shop using a minimum of three (3) inch sized numbers that are placed on the driver's side of the back of the mobile salon/barber shop.

Rule 13.10 Mobile Salon / Barber Shop License Renewal A mobile salon / barber shop license must be renewed biennially. An application entitled "mobile salon / barber shop establishment renewal" available on the Board's website or otherwise may be made available by the Board. The application must be accompanied by the non-refundable application fee and all documents required by the Board.

A mobile salon / barber shop license that is not renewed within one (1) year from the date of expiration must make a new application for licensure complying with Rule 13.5 and successfully complete the inspection described in Rule 13.6.

No license shall be renewed until all fines previously assessed to the establishment have been paid.

Rule 13.11 Display of Barber Pole A barber pole is a pole or cylinder with alternating stripes of any combination including, but not limited to, red and white or red, white, and blue, which run diagonally along the length of the cylinder or pole; or any depiction, rendering, or other representation of a “barber pole” that appears in any form, which would create the impression to members of the general public that a business located near the object is a licensed to offer the services of barbering.

A barber pole may be displayed only if the establishment is licensed to offer the services of barbering.

Rule 13.12 Annual Inspections All mobile salon / barber shops licensed by the Board shall be inspected, with or without prior announcement, annually at minimum. The Board or its agent(s) may conduct a mobile salon / barber shop inspection as part of the investigation of a complaint. Interference with an inspection may result in the issuance of a citation for violation and may result in further discipline.

Records of the following must be kept within the mobile establishment unit and made available for inspection by department personnel: appointments; itineraries, if the establishment submits itineraries to the department as provided by subsection (d); license numbers of employees and independent contractors; and vehicle identification numbers of the mobile establishment. Records of appointments and itineraries must be kept for a period of at least one year from the date the record is made.

A licensee shall make his government issued photo identification available upon request of the Board or its agent(s).

A mobile salon / barber shop shall meet all applicable health and safety standards required by local, state, and/or federal law.
